



DefShutDown

Defensive shutdown solution

DisableLogging=1

- Commercial users can set =0 and any program specific activity will be recorded to the event log
- Event recording is disabled by default

MaxFailedPWAttempts=5

- Users can set =[1-999] in order to trigger the shutdown after x failed logon events
- A successful logon event will reset the counter to 0.
- This feature only works for commercial users and is enabled by default.

ShutdownPowerPluggedOff=0

- Users can set =1 and trigger a shutdown when the device is no longer connected to a power source, e.g. laptop charging cable removed
- This function is disabled by default

InitialH=6

- Users can set `=[1-99]` in order to set the default shutdown trigger time in hours
- The default delay are six hours

Additional commercial features

- Enhanced process guard
- File access protection, e.g. config file or license cannot be access by anyone
- Ghost mode aka a hidden execution to shutdown the device no matter what = no visible user interface nor any option to disable the program
